Senior Classical League

The <u>Senior Classical League</u> is an organization made up of college-age students, who share a continuing interest in the classics and a commitment to helping the Junior Classical League at national convention. During the NJCL Convention, members of the SCL are responsible for organizing all Ludi and Olympika events, producing *That's Entertainment*, and publishing the daily newsletter, the *Convention Ear*. In addition, the SCL has its own General Assemblies, elections, and a banquet near the end of convention.

High School graduates of 2017 are invited to join SCL at this summer's national convention. JCL delegates who join SCL are welcome at all SCL functions, are eligible to vote, and to hold office. However, for the convention during the summer after high school graduation, they are still regarded as JCL delegates and therefore must abide by the rules, including curfew, laid down for JCL delegates in this convention booklet. Current SCL members are expected to follow the same guidelines as sponsors and chaperones. They are also expected to assist with SCL activities. Current SCLers may also sign up for or be assigned Chaperone or Sponsor duties (if qualified).

Primary dues (good for four years) are \$6.00 and will be collected throughout the week of convention. A convention registration fee of \$4.00 will be collected from all SCLers to cover SCL convention costs. Current SCL members may request special housing if they are not serving as chaperones and have paid their SCL Registration fee. SCL registration will take place on Monday, July 24, 2017 - 8:00 am - 11:45 am (see program for location). SCL registration will also occur during the SCL Reception on Monday, July 24, 2017 - 7:00 pm - 8:00 pm, immediately preceding the SCL General Assembly.
